Our Story

Building Forever Families – Adoption & Family Services was founded by adoption advocate, Barb Pearson-Cramer. Barb says, "I have been advocating for adoption since 2000 and have been an adoption caseworker since 2006. I wanted to continue my personal mission of serving families during the adoption process and continue my advocacy work. I believe that every client deserves personal attention before, during and after their adoption." Building Forever Families – Adoption & Family Services was founded in March

of 2016 when licensing approval in North Dakota was obtained. In April of 2017, licensing approval was obtained in South Dakota. Since the inception, Building Forever Families – Adoption & Family Services has had 25 placements including; two placements in 2016, six placements in 2017, twelve in 2018 and five placements to date in 2019. Our staff has presented adoption information at social work conferences, to medical students and have advocated for adoption in the South Dakota and North Dakota legislatures. YES! We have been busy. YES! We love what we are doing. So the next big news is that we are currently working on licensing in another state!

Forever Families Adoption Alliance

In 2018, Barb and husband, Trevor, decided that there also needed to be an option for fundraising and providing scholarships to birth families and adoptive families. They founded Forever Families Adoption Alliance, a non-profit 501 (c) 3 organization. \$12,000 was raised in 2018 and 4 grants were given that year totaling \$11,000. The grants were awarded to families in need of financial assistance to complete their adoptions. All 4 situations were where the children had special needs. In 2019, one grant has been awarded in the amount of \$500. This grant was for medical care that was not covered by any insurance.

Our Current Financial Need - Goal

Our goal for 2019 is fundraising \$50,000. We currently have two cases where families need financial assistance in order to cover the expenses of the adoptions and one case where the child needs medical care that is not covered. PLEASE consider a donation and help us reach our goal.
